Inventory Reports, by state

The human remains of Native American individuals in approximately 16,000 catalog numbers from the United States were reported in the 1998 inventories, as well as the entire collection of over 225,000 archaeological catalog records from the United States (representing well over 1,000,000 artifacts), some of which are funerary objects. A table listing these reports, organized by state, is found below; copies of the full catalog by catalog number inventory report are available from the Repatriation Office upon request. These inventory reports do not included the human remains and objects that were repatriated prior to the inventories or the number of uncataloged human remains and objects that were listed in 1998 inventories. Since the completion of the 1998 inventories, the human remains of approximately 650 individuals that were listed in the inventories, but not counted in the above 16,000 total, have been cataloged, bringing the total number of catalog number of Native American human remains from the United States at the National Museum of Natural History in 1998 to approximately 16,650.
