

## ANTHRONOTES INDEX

*AnthroNotes*, the award winning publication of the Smithsonian's Department of Anthropology, was published from 1979-2012 in order to present archaeological and anthropological research to educators and the public in an engaging and accessible style.

This *AnthroNotes* Index represents 33 years of print publication. All 84 issues, from spring 1979 through winter 2012, are now available through the [Smithsonian Institution Libraries Digital Repository](#). Over 260 articles, with new abstracts, are fully searchable and downloadable as separate articles, available in three formats designed for computers (pdf), Mobile devices (mobi), and e-readers (E-pub). Over 40 subject topics are listed on the Digital Repository offering a way to search all issues by topic as well as by author, title, and date. The topics include anthropology subfields (archaeology, linguistics); geographic regions (Africa, Middle East); contemporary issues (refugees, genetics); and education (teaching activities and resources).

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
